OPERATION GRATEFUL & SUPPORT

Truckee Sanitation Workers - a request from Pastor Jeanie

As I shop around Truckee, so many people express their gratitude to our church simply for being grateful. As the onslaught of tourists has been particularly harsh these last few weeks, the appreciation for our local essential workers is more important than ever. The next group that our Social Action, Mission and Justice and Outreach committees has chosen to thank is our sanitation workers in Truckee. I learned a lot this week as I spoke to workers up on "the hill" on Cabin Creek Road at the Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Facility. It is a family owned business with roots in salvage and collection that date back to 1896 when Italian immigrant Silvano Achiro first landed in San Francisco from his home in Italy. His grandson came to Truckee in 1960 and he and his wife scraped together everything they owned to purchase the disposal company. Today they have 105 employees ranging from drivers, mechanics, material recovery, scale operators, and sorters. All of the workers have continued working during the entire pandemic. All of them at risk as they pick up and sort garbage from our homes and businesses in Truckee. As the recent articles and protests in Truckee over the litter strewn river bed where tourists raft down the Truckee River has shown, without an effective sanitation and garbage collection system our health and the health of the ecosystem in the Tahoe basin would be compromised and endangered. The most memorable part of my day was when I was introduced to so many of our sanitation workers and their absolute shock that I was there to thank them for their service. Time and time and time again, I heard, "We have never had anyone thank us before." I look forward to spending the next two weeks thanking our sanitation workers in Truckee! And I hope we will all take time to write a letter to thank them for their work. With these workers, it will REALLY make an impact!
