Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal has 105 employees ranging from drivers, mechanics, material recovery, scale operators, and sorters. All of the workers have continued working during the entire pandemic. All of them at risk as they pick up and sort garbage from our homes and businesses in Truckee. As the recent articles and protests in Truckee over the litter strewn river bed where tourists raft down the Truckee River has shown, without an effective sanitation and garbage collection system our health and the health of the ecosystem in the Tahoe basin would be compromised and endangered.
