When I was a young girl, my father worked for General Electric back in the day when they moved their young engineers around the country every few years. My dad was transferred to Indiana, a long way from our New England roots and family.

On special holidays, like Thanksgiving and Christmas, my parents would have my sister and me practice what we would say on the rare and expensive long-distance calls to my grandparents back east. We would each have a minute or so to share about our school activities and my grandparents would always say, "This is so expensive, it's your nickel." I remember those phone calls and how much they meant, hearing their voices and their love. But it is the letters that I still cherish, written in my grandmother's beautiful hand, posted with the five cent JFK stamp in the corner.

Travel has made being together on holidays so relatively easy and our expectations, unlike those of my childhood, are that we will be able to be sharing the same table.
