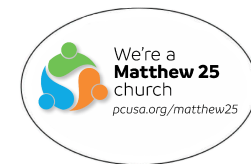

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR JEANIE



I know you all have seen this icon, "The Hospitality of Abraham," painted by Russian iconographer Andrei Rublev in the 15th Century. It is the best known of all paintings depicting the Trinity. The painting shows the Father wearing gold, the Son wearing blue, and the Holy Spirit who is garbed in green, sitting at a table with Abraham under the great oaks of Mamre.

The wonder of the painting is in its subtle communication. The Father is looking at the Son. The Son gazes at the Father but his hand is gesturing toward the Spirit, and the Spirit looks at the Father but is pointing to the Son. All three are connected and yet there is room at the table for us, as if there was a place set for us and we are invited to join them.

I remember a moment from my trip as a seminarian to Russia. In one of the great cathedrals of Leningrad, a Russian woman took my hand and led me around the cathedral, pointing to each of the icons, sharing her faith through these beautiful paintings.

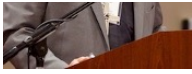
