A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAT

Beloved, Let Us Love One Another

The sermon that day must have been on 1 John 4:7-8. Mom was frying up some chicken for Sunday dinner while out in the living room, the three older siblings were standing in a triangle, arguing more and more loudly about something. Suddenly, the youngest (couldn't have been more than 5 years old) squeezed into the triangle and shouted up to the older brother and sisters, "LOVE ONE ANOTHER!" The argument ceased because the participants dissolved into laughter! The mini sermon achieved its objective, but only because the preacher was so ludicrous.

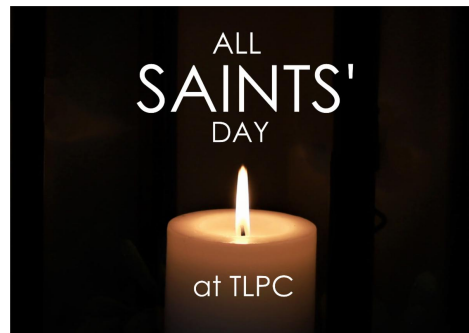
Rev. Rick Cole is Founder and current leader of Capital Compassion, a non-profit ministry serving Sacramento.

In addition, you can honor your loved ones by glueing a glass bead on the Broken Glass Cross for each person who has died during the past year. The Broken Glass Cross, beads, and glass glue will be available downstairs in the Fellowship Room at church on Sunday, Nov. 3.

Please list your loved one's names and place a bead on the Broken Glass Cross prior to the November 10 ALL SAINTS DAY worship service.
