A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR REBECCA



Friends in Christ,

The Rev. Sipes Parsonage has an interesting history. It was built in 1873 (the indoor bathroom and laundry room were added later). I was surprised to learn that there was at one time a garage on the property, but that part of the lot was lost when the new highway (Donner Pass Road) went through. Several times, the house was in such bad repair that the church voted to sell it or demolish it but never got around to it. There was

even one time when a gas leak caused an explosion in it. Here we are, 150 years later, still trying to save it.

After five years of tireless effort, primarily by Dave McCormick and Dennis Dodds, the Town of Truckee Planning Division finally approved the permit to renovate the outside of the Sipes Parsonage, my future home. The permit is good for two years and covers the replacement of the foundation and back steps, a new skirt, new windows, and new siding (the old siding, which is crumbling, is asbestos).

The day after the permit was issued, the contractor's crew started working. The goal for this year is to complete the foundation and replace the skirt and back steps. After that is finished—hopefully, by the first part of October—we will have just a little over a month to build closets, renovate the kitchen, replace the flooring, and paint the walls. We will be scheduling workdays and inviting friends and family (and folks from other churches) who are handy with tools or paintbrushes to come to an old-fashioned "parsonage raising," so don't plan to go anywhere in October or early November!


We have already received some very generous gifts to get the renovations going, and I want to express my deep gratitude to TLPC for the donation of \$14,000 to the Sipes fund. We have a long way to go, but at long last, we are on the move.

Sierra Community House – Hunger Relief provides weekly food distributions in Truckee, King's Beach, and Incline Village. In addition, they provide home food delivery service for community members that are homebound and "Cooking Compromised Food Bags" for community members that do not have access to cooking or have an emergency need.

TLPC's "God's Work. Our Hands." volunteers will be working at the *Sierra Community House – Hunger Relief* warehouse (located at 12116 Chandelle Way, Suite D2, near the Truckee Airport) starting after worship at 10:30 am on Sunday, September 7. Upon arriving at the warehouse, participants will listen to a short presentation on *Sierra Community House* and their work in the North Tahoe / Truckee area and we will be given instructions on how to complete our project. We will then go to work filling "Cooking Compromised Food Bags" that will be distributed to community members in need. Our service work at the warehouse will end no later than noon.


