A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR REBECCA



By the time you read this, I will be in the midst of moving into the Sipes parsonage. Over a few short weeks, I saw a very old, sagging building become a new and charming home.

Since I will be spending most of my Advent getting settled, I decided that "Coming Home" would be a good theme for my Advent sermons this year.

For the first Sunday of Advent, the lectionary gives us scriptures that focus not on the coming of baby Jesus, but the Second Coming of our risen Lord. some light on the question of whether we are ready to welcome him into our homes and into our hearts.

And where is God in your homecoming story? These are some of the questions we will explore this season, and remember, wherever you spend the holidays, Jesus will be waiting for you to come home to him.


Whoever you are, I'm sure you are on someone's gratitude list this year, and I pray that you will have a very blessed Thanksgiving weekend.
